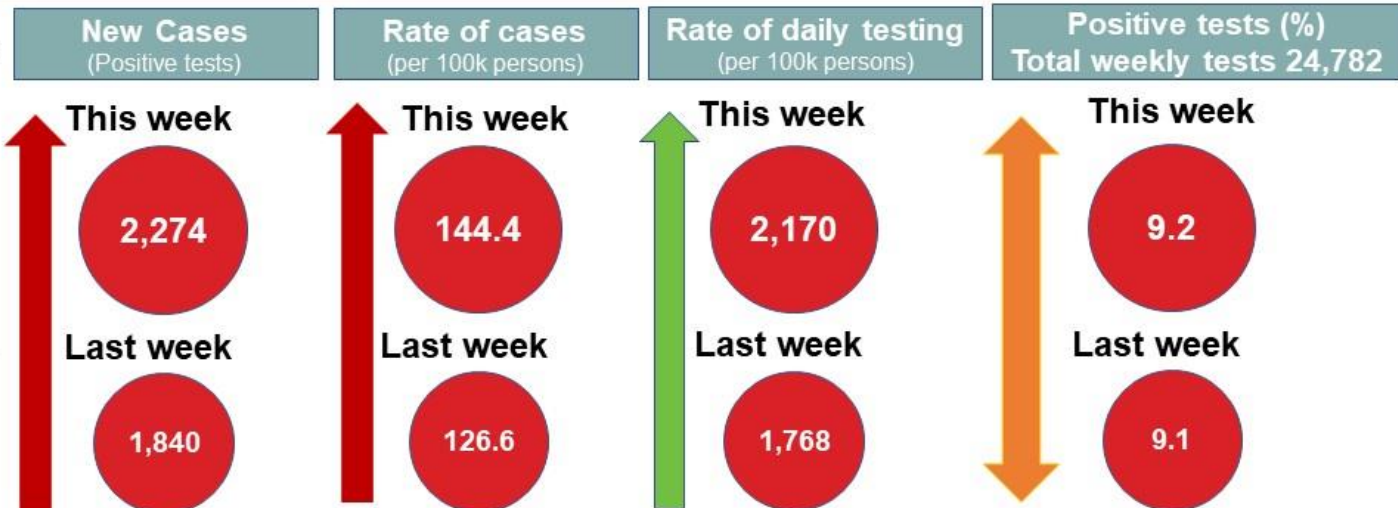

The rate of cases has increased, this reflects an increase in the number of tests being done and also a small increase in the percentage of tests that are positive.

There has been consistent increase in the number of people testing positive across all age groups under 65yrs, but over the last week there has been a significant increase in 20-29yr age group and there has also been an increase in the over 80yr age group for the first time since the relaxation of lockdown. There has also been a significant increase in the number of people from White British ethnic group testing positive, especially in older age groups.

Hospitalisations remain a concern for the numbers in intensive care, or supported by oxygen, due to Covid, as these have increased significantly over the last couple of weeks.
